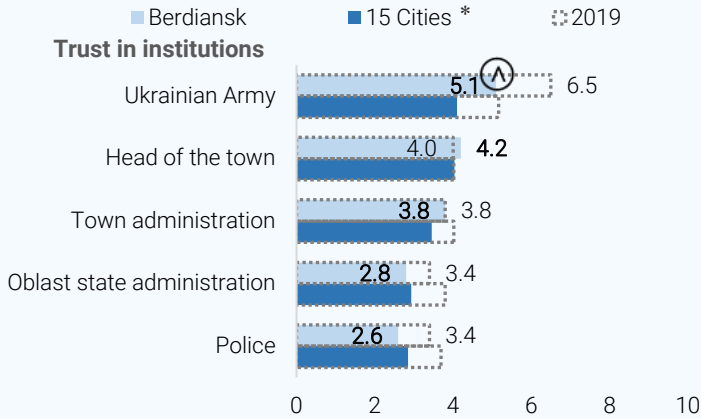


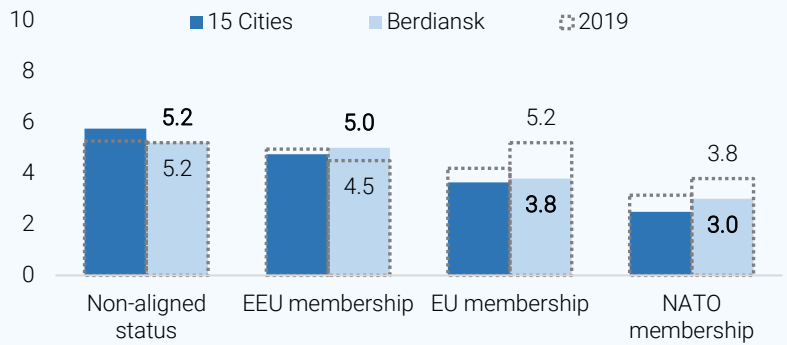

## GOOD GOVERNANCE



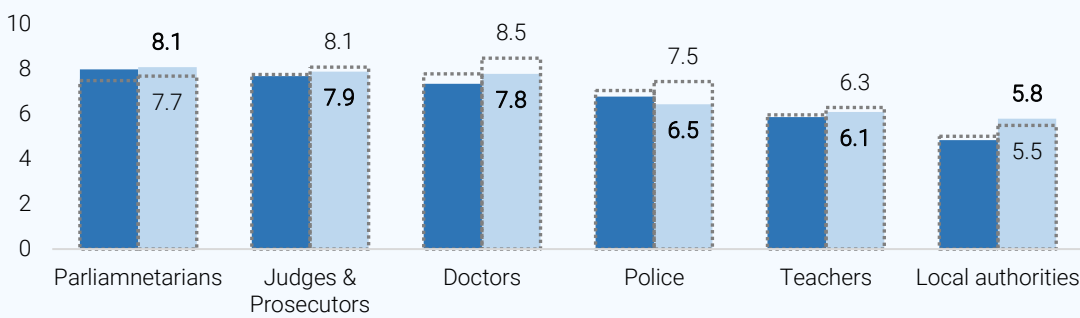
Despite the decrease of perceived corruption among police, 75% of citizens in Berdiansk do not trust the police.

## Geo-political aspirations



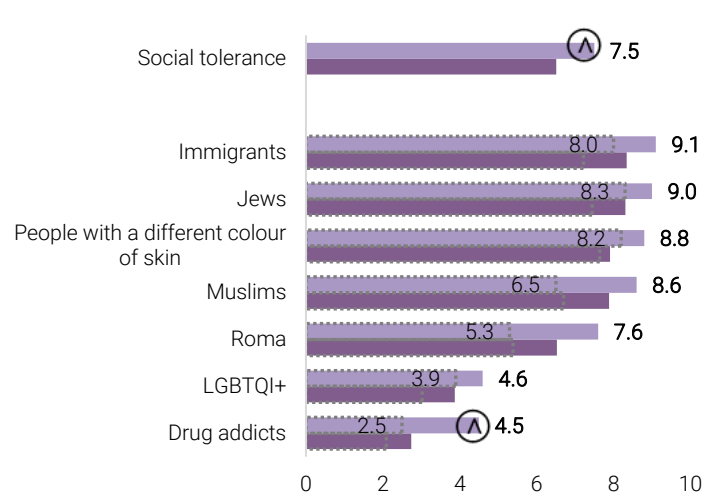
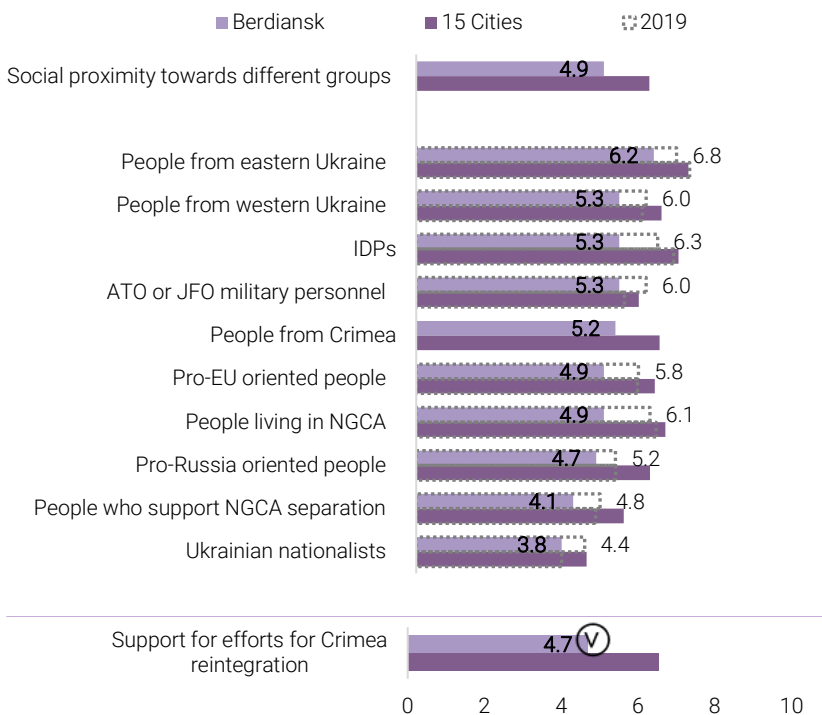
Despite the recent local elections, trust in town and oblast administration decreased compared to 2019. Support civic participation initiatives to improve vertical cohesion and confidence in authorities to improve inclusivity, accessibility and quality of public services based on citizens' needs and including better and more reflective dialogue about reforms.

## Perceived corruption



On the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2021, the National Anti-Corruption Bureau with support of the EU Anti-Corruption Initiative in Ukraine (EUACI) adopted an anti-corruption strategy supporting institutional development, transparent information infrastructure, watchdogs, investigative media, and accountability mechanisms. Capitalize on or draw inspiration from these initiatives to tackle corruption.

## COMMUNITY BONDS



Capitalize on the tolerant mindset of people in Berdiansk as an entry point to strengthen community cooperation and inter-group harmony among socio-political and demographic groups. Facilitate safe spaces for dialogue to overcome social divides and stereotypes.

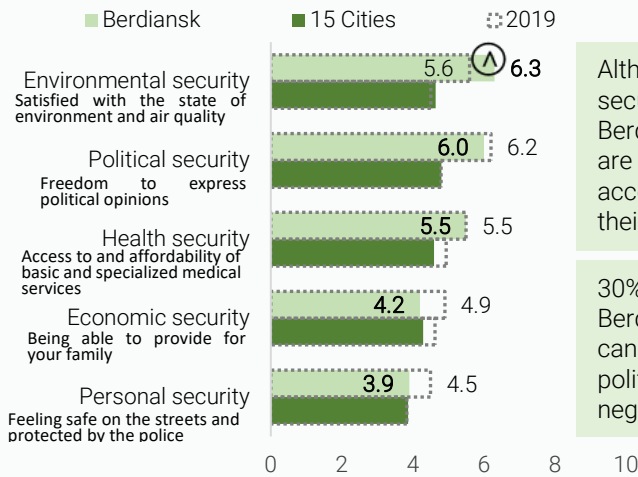

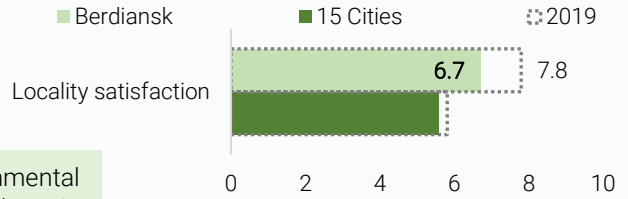
## SATISFACTION WITH LIFE IN BERDIANSK

### Safety & Security



Although environmental security is the highest in Berdiansk, 65% of citizens are not satisfied with their access to clean water in their locality.

30% of citizens in Berdiansk do not feel they can freely express their political views without negative repercussions.

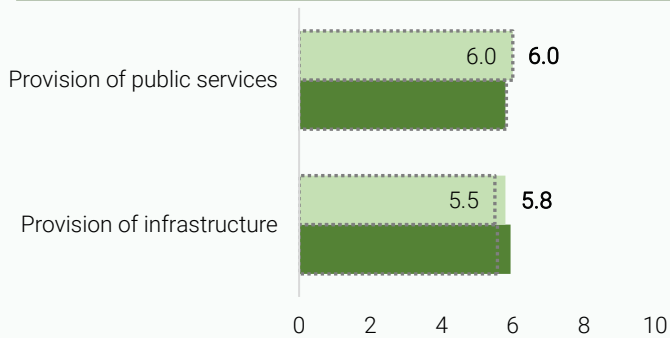


29% of citizens in Berdiansk experience a lack of leisure activities in their locality.

**Citizens in Berdiansk lack personal safety and security. Establish online early-warning systems in collaboration with the district police where people can report any suspicious activities. This could also improve the responsiveness of the police force and their visibility. Organize public meetings with local authorities and police to discuss causes of insecurity to design tailored interventions responding to citizens' fears.**

72% of citizens in Berdiansk do not feel confident that the police can protect them from violence. 62% does not feel safe walking alone in the street at night.

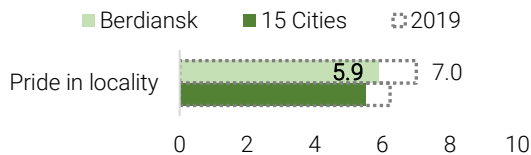
### Provision of Services



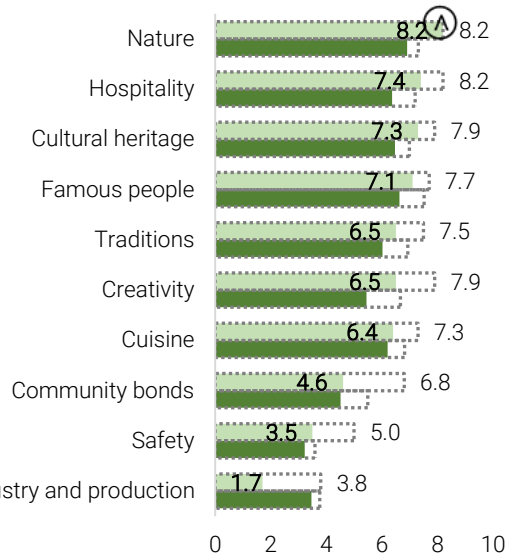
81% of citizens in Berdiansk are not satisfied with the quality of roads. Roads are important to connect rural communities, to foster entrepreneurship and economic activity and to improve mobility in general by cutting time and cost of transportation.

### Pride in your locality

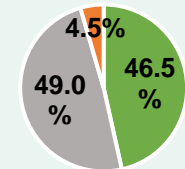
When you think about your locality, to what extent are you proud of the following?



**Pride in locality decreased in Berdiansk. Establish and promote 'green' initiatives (e.g., neighbourhood clean-up, circular economy including 2<sup>nd</sup> hand sale and exchange, recycling projects, consultancy) and 'green' networks developing expertise on green innovations to inform the industry.**
