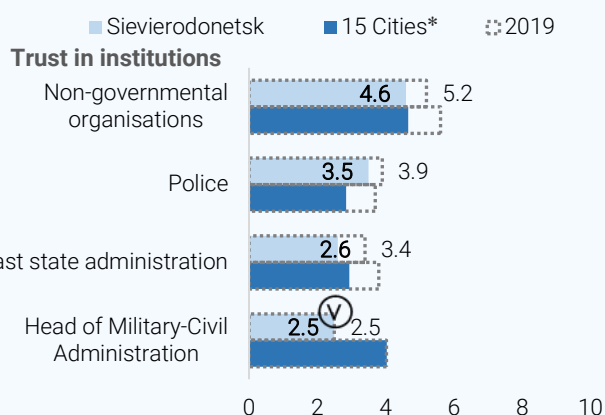


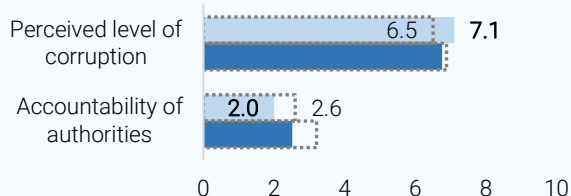


SIEVIERODONETSK 2021, CITY PROFILE

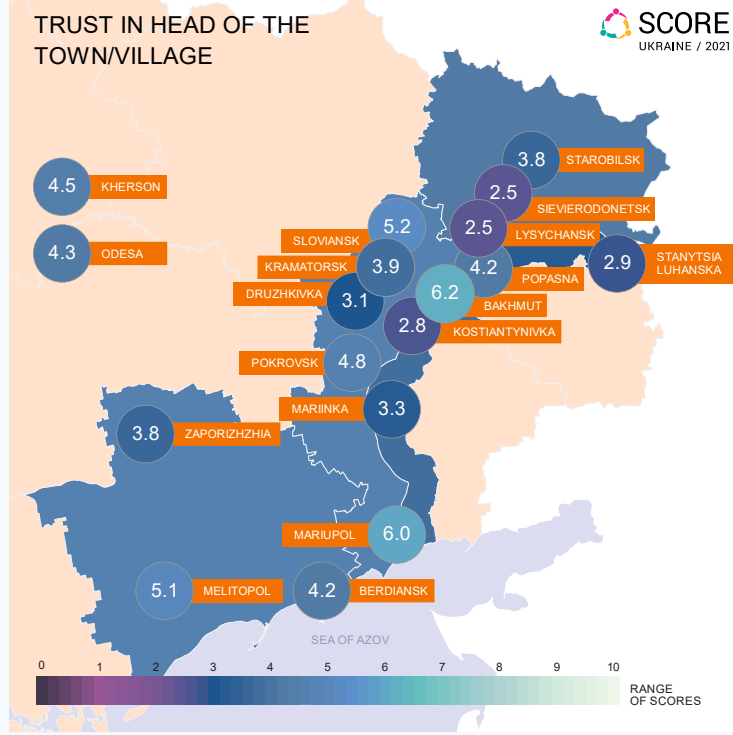
GOOD GOVERNANCE



Citizens in Sievierodonetsk became significantly less trusting of oblast state administration and have the lowest trust in their head of MCA compared to other cities in the region.



Only 7% of citizens in Sievierodonetsk believe that authority representatives are and can be held accountable. Citizens also perceive more corruption compared to 2019, especially among parliamentarians and judges.



Support information campaigns about reform processes and anti-corruption initiatives (e.g., young people against corruption project by UNDP 2019) allowing for inclusion of citizens in local governance and fostering transparency to restore the relations between local authorities and citizens.

COMMUNITY BONDS

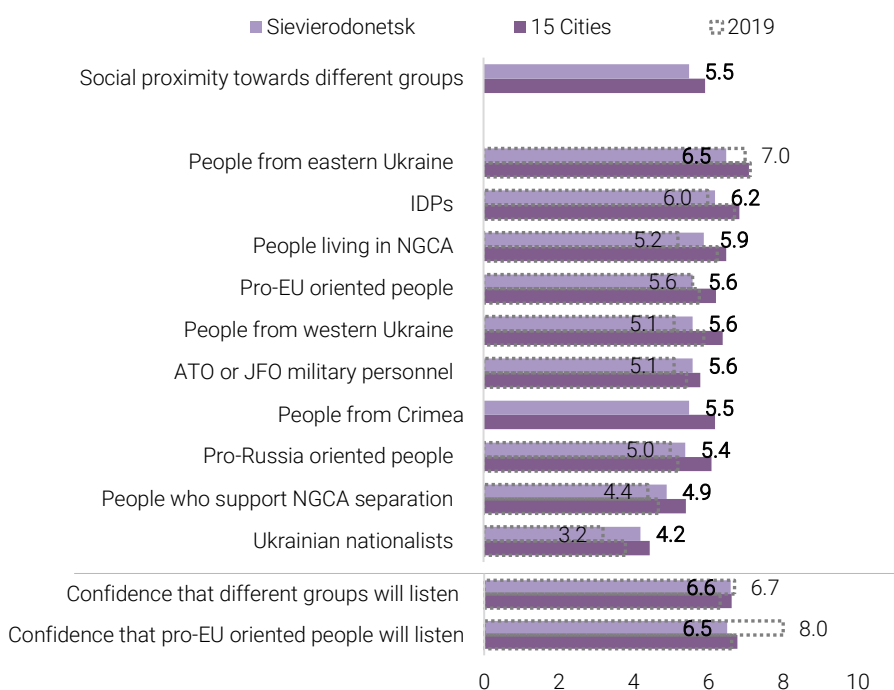
Citizens in Sievierodonetsk became more acceptant of most socio-demographic, geographic, and political groups compared to 2019. However, socio-political dynamics have changed with people being more sceptical that pro-EU oriented people will listen in a discussion and 36% believing European values threaten their value system.

21% of citizens in Sievierodonetsk have felt marginalized because of their native language.

70% of citizens in Sievierodonetsk believe that linguistic differences are enriching their national identity compared to 53% in 2019.

Promote the value of diversity across interventions to build acceptance and respect towards different groups. Give a voice to people who feel marginalized to raise awareness and tackle unfair practices. Also incorporating life skill trainings around empathy, growth-mindset, and critical thinking could support constrictive discussions around the mitigation of marginalization.

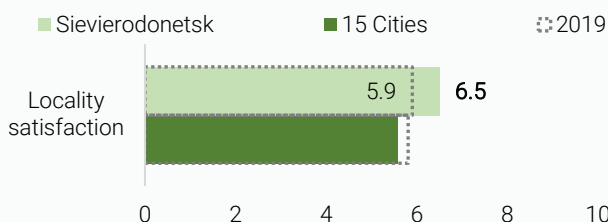
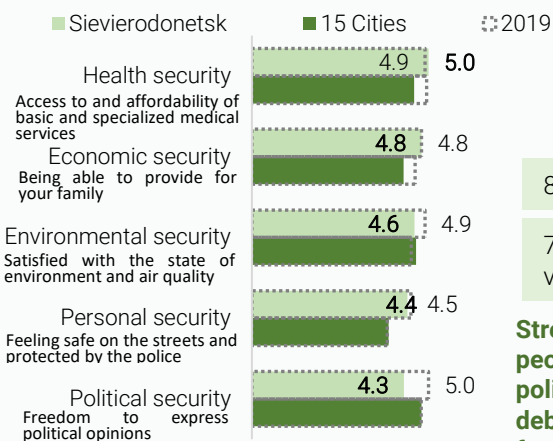

Safety & Security

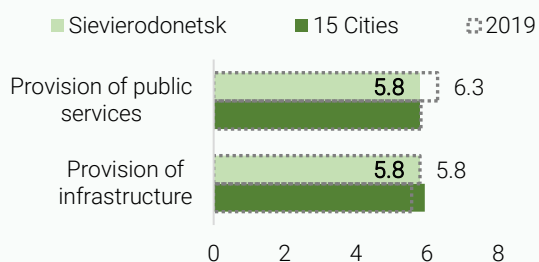


83% of citizens in Sievierodonetsk are satisfied with access to clean water.

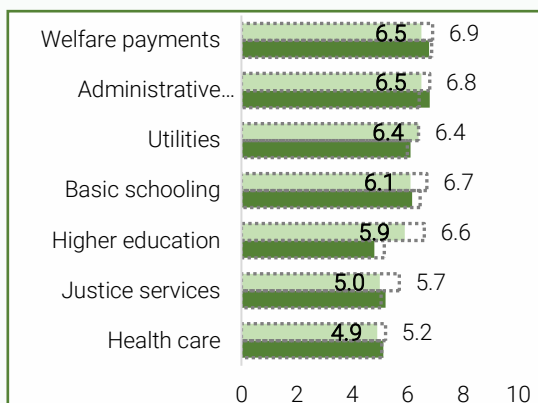
76% of citizens in Sievierodonetsk feel they cannot express their political views without negative repercussions (compared to 57% in 2019).

Strengthen legal support for people prosecuted based on political beliefs. Facilitate public debates providing safe spaces for citizens in Sievierodonetsk to express their political views.

Provision of Services

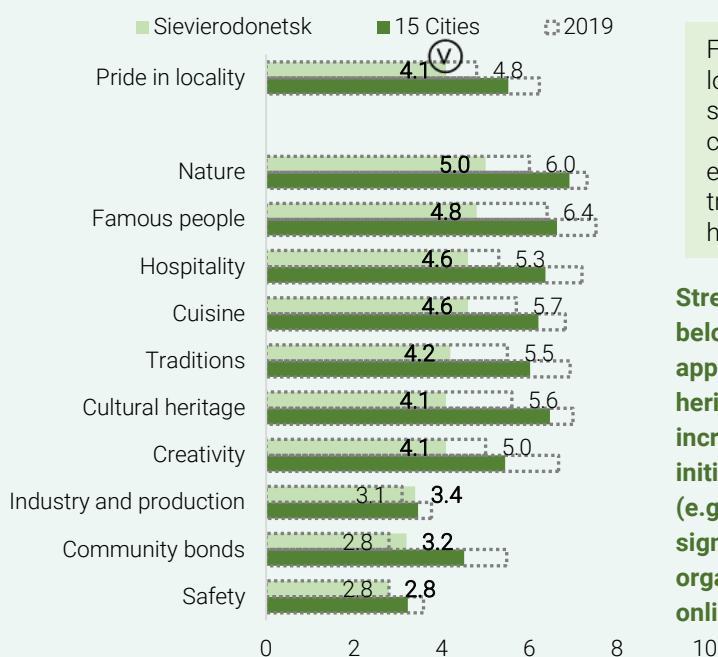


Identify perceived deficiencies in educational and justice services to improve basic services that link to human security, legitimacy, and accountability of governance institutions.



Pride in your locality

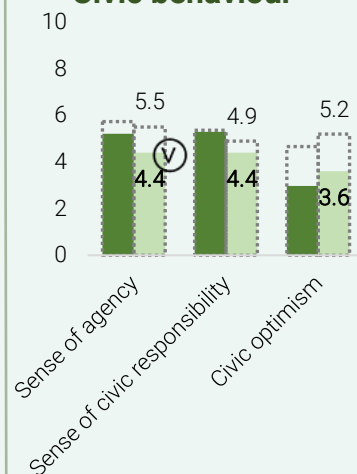
When you think about your locality, to what extent are you proud of the following?



Feelings of pride in one's locality decreased significantly among citizens in Sievierodonetsk especially pride in local traditions and cultural heritage.

Strengthen the sense of belonging cultivating appreciation of cultural heritage and the locality by increasing visibility of local initiatives and unique traits (e.g., invest in information signs around historic sites or organize thematic outdoor or online events).

71% believes ordinary people cannot change anything in the community.

Encourage civic engagement through communal activities strengthening agency through civic leadership projects.
