SCORE in Ukraine







- SCORE Ukraine has been a joint initiative funded by USAID and UNDP, and implemented by SeeD
- Since 2016, SCORE Ukraine has been serving as an **annual assessment tool** for various desirable outcomes that relate to elements of and drivers of social cohesion.
- Following Russia's full-scale invasion, SCORE Ukraine was recalibrated to focus on **Resilience Recovery and Reconstruction of an inclusive, just, cohesive and prosperous Ukraine** with a cross cutting social cohesion lens, and renamed as **reSCORE**.
- reSCORE Ukraine continues to serve as a sophisticated tool that informs the policies and programming of national, regional and international partners with robust and longitudinal evidence.


Data from the SCORE in Ukraine has been used for monitoring and evaluation, to inform regional strategies and reforms, and to design interventions of CSO, international donors and government

SCORE in Ukraine









Since 2016, we garnered **10 different SCORE Ukraine datasets**, and published 60+ social cohesion related reports and analytical products, along with 40+ infographics such as city profiles and fact sheets.

reSCORE 2024: Sampling







Survey Methodology: F2F, structured, quantitative household interviews based on stratified random sampling.

Data Collection Period: May 30 - September 5, 2024.

Main Sample: ~7,780 across the territories under the control of Ukraine, including ~1,800 from 6 geographical boosters (i.e. in Kirovohrad oblast, and in 5 cities: Kryvyi Rih, Dnipro, Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia, and Odesa.)

Panel data: respondents surveyed face-to-face in both 2023 and 2024 (n = \sim 650).


Other booster samples:


- Mykolaiv oblast (n = ~300).
- Veterans who are currently not in service but participated in combat (n = ~500).
- Young people (aged 18-35) from Chernihiv, Dnipropetrovsk, Kharkiv, Kherson, Mykolaiv, Poltava, Sumy & Zaporizhzhia oblasts (n = ~500).
- IDP's in Kirovohrad, Kharkiv, Dnipropetrovsk, Zaporizhzhia, Odesa and Mykolaiv oblasts (n= ~500).


reSCORE 2024: Sample Distribution

















How to read SCORE?

A score is calculated for each indicator. The scores range from 0 to 10, where 0 means that the phenomenon the indicator is measuring is not observed in the context at all, and 10 means that it is observed strongly and prevalently.

Personal security: The degree to which one feels safe from violence in daily life, that they can walk alone in the street at night and that the police can protect them.


Aggression: The degree to which one is aggressive in daily life, such as frequently getting into fights and confrontations.

What is the state of vertical and horizontal social cohesion in Ukraine in 2024? How has it changed in the past three years?


SOCIAL COHESION

Key messages:

- Vertical cohesion is volatile and challenged. The increases experienced in 2022-2023 have dissipated. Although civic duty is moderate, citizens feel that authorities are neither accountable nor that they care for their needs and interests. The scores have mostly returned to their pre-2022 state.
- Horizontal cohesion which grew stronger after 2022 has remained reliably high. Pluralism and sense of belonging have expanded from local and regional identities and became more overarching. Community cooperation is stable at respectable levels, but social tolerance is stagnant and conservative. Growing levels of perceived social threat may pose a risk to horizontal cohesion, which has shown resilience since 2022.








How has economic security, perception of economic stability and employment opportunities changed in the past three years, and where do they stand in 2024?


STATE OF THE ECONOMY


Key messages:

- Economic opportunities are not dwindling due to a thinning labour market as approximately 7 million people have left the labour market, and Economic security is at the pre-full scale invasion levels.
- However, fear of economic instability is high, many fear losing their
 jobs in the next year. This hinders economic activity, causes anxiety
 and undermines individual investment, be it entrepreneurship, investing
 in assets or education.







How prevalent is direct personal exposure to war almost three years after the full-scale invasion? What is the state and the dynamics of mental health indicators?


MENTAL HEALTH & WELLBEING

Key messages:

- Direct and personal exposure to war is very high, and even higher among IDPs. 1 in 2 IDPs have experienced damage to their homes or property due to military actions.
- Mental wellbeing parameters highlight the need for holistic mental health and psychosocial support services including family/household level programming beyond individual counselling.





INFORMATION CONSUMPTION


Key messages:




Which sources and how often do you use to get information about political affairs?



INFORMATION CONSUMPTION DYNAMIC




